Lisa poke to Boyd Jackson today and confirmed that NaturEner is going to pursue legal action. Boyd confirmed that in the state of Montana there has never been a settlement in favor of the state. Boyd provided history on extlements which range of 5-27%. Dan asked why we weren't waiting until the budget process was completed in August. Lisa K. explained that it had to do with negotiations. Further discussion followed regarding pros and cons of taking all of the protested taxes. Lisa K. pointed out that the new board will be ble to review this issue again if it is determined that more taxes are needed. Amanda indicated that regotiations could be done based on how much is available. After further discussion, Lisa K. asked for iscussion with just the board.
